GREEK INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE

The Annual Greek Independence Day and Hellenic Heritage Parade is this Sunday, April 25, at 2:30 p.m., on Halsted Street. Our Day school will march with the Evening and Saturday Schools of the HAA. Our school parade order is #58. The meeting point for teachers, students, and parents will be at the corner of Halsted and Randolph Streets, at 2:20 P.M. Please pick up your children after they march, at the corner of Van Buren & Halsted by Costas and Giordano's restaurants. The dress code for the Parade is as follows:

BOYS: school uniform, navy blue pants with their formal white shirt, the Academy's jacket, and black shoes.

GIRLS: school uniform, skirt or jumper with their formal white blouse, the Academy's jacket, black shoes, and white socks.

Students are also welcome to march in national *Greek costumes* if available.

Pre-school children are welcome to participate in the parade provided that they are accompanied by their parents. We expect to see all students and parents participating in the parade, showing their pride in our school and our Greek heritage.
