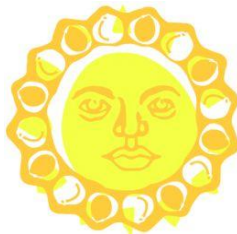

Our Junior Camp Program has been carefully planned to use fun summer activities as a means to introduce and reinforce basic educational concepts in both Greek and English. Your child will be learning but also running, playing outside, singing and making friends. Watch your child blossom as he/she takes a joyful journey with us through a wide variety of bilingual and bi-cultural experiences.



OUR JUNIOR CAMP FORMAT

Our Junior Camp is specifically designed for children ages 2.5 to 7. The program extends over a 7 week session (June 14 – July 30) but families may elect to participate on a weekly or even daily basis. Families may also choose from the regular day (9am – 1pm) or extended day (9am – 3pm) options.

Each day's activities are centered around a different theme. Educational activities (such as reading, counting and measuring) are incorporated into the day's theme in both English and Greek.

Time is also made for daily sports and play. Campers are asked to bring a bathing suit, a beach towel, sunscreen and footwear suitable for games such as soccer each day.

- ❖ Social & Emotional Development
- ❖ Physical Development
